Most Rev. Timothy Senior to celebrate Mass for Leadership Roundtable

This year's meeting, "A Blueprint for Responsibility: Responding to Crises with Collaborative Solutions," will offer ideas to strengthen the Church as it encounters new revelations of clergy sexual abuse across the globe, as well as address the precarious situation in which Catholic organizations find themselves as a result of the worldwide economic collapse.
